Happy Spring

Our grade 3 and 6 provincial testing this year will occur between May 21 and May 31, with the grade three students writing between May 21 and 24, and the grade six students writing between May 27 and 31. Please make every effort to ensure that your grade 3 or 6 student is well-rested, eats a nutritious breakfast, is at school on time, and is encouraged by you to do his or her best. Because we want to do everything we can to facilitate the testing process, we are asking that you do not bring your grade 3 or 6 student late to school or ask for early dismissal on those days, unless absolutely necessary. Students who are in combined grades with the tested students will have their days structured slightly different than usual so that their "tested: classmates are given prime opportunity to complete the testing with the classroom teacher. This may mean that the combined grade students may be expected to carry out an independent activity quietly for a period of time. As always, if you need to pick up your student from the other half of the combined grade group early, please proceed to the office and ask that s/he be located and asked to report to the office.. In this way you can avoid accidentally interrupting an important component of our testing.

With the end of this school year in sight, we are now looking forward to the fall and starting the planning process of staffing and class placements for September. Also, with the nicer weather, we have some more outdoor activities starting back up, including tack and field and three pitch starting in the next few weeks. Classes will also be taking advantage of the nicer weather and doing more outdoor activities.
